- A minimum of two (2) years' relevant employment experience

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Participants will complete course work offered by the Fisheries and Marine Institute of Memorial University on one of two Program Routes:

Option 1: (Course Route) requires 3 core courses (9 credit hours) and 7 elective courses (21 credit hours)

Option 2: (Project Route) requires 3 core courses (9 credit hours), 5 elective courses (15 credit hours) and comprehensive 6 credit hour capstone research project and report course.
